

## TSR Judges Mentor Information Sheet

### Why are TSR looking for Mentors?

TSR is compiling a list of judges who are happy to mentor trainee judges as part of The TSR Judges Training Program. We would be delighted if existing panel judges wished to help shape the future judges of showing through becoming a mentor.

### Who can apply to be a Mentor?

To be a judges mentor you....

- Need to have at least 2 yrs judging experience
- Judged at County Show Level
- Be a panel judge for either NPS, TSR, BSPS, P(UK), BSHA, Sport Horse (GB), CHAPS, SSADL or a Breed Society

### What do I have to do as a Mentor?

Judges Mentors will be expected to assist trainee judges in the following ways

- Be prepared & willing for trainee judges to contact them for their thoughts on aspects of judging.
- Allow a trainee judge to stand in with them at shows they are officiating at (not HOYS qualifiers)
- If possible provide other opportunities to allow trainees to gain experience

**Basic Mentoring** - This will be in the form of providing support via phone and opportunities to stand in at shows when judging.

**Developed Mentoring** - Basic mentoring plus assisting the trainee to gain wider experience through other avenues in relation to the mentors equine experience. For example mentors that breed or own horses/ponies might be able to arrange stud visits, meeting at sales, demos or other types of equine event etc.

### How will it Work?

- Register your interest to be a TSR Mentor.
- Your name will be added to the Mentor List and sent to Trainee Judges.
- Trainee Judges will choose their mentors relevant to the experience they wish to gain.
- TSR will contact you to inform you that a trainee judge may contact you.
- The trainee judge will contact you to talk and hopefully arrange a mutually convenient show/event to attend with you. If date/commitments are not compatible then the trainee judge will have to seek another mentor.
- The trainee will contact the show/event and ask permission to stand in with you and offer their services to steward.
- Trainees should have their own personal insurance and will be covered by the show/events insurance as a voluntary official the same as stewards/judges etc.
- Trainees will not be able to compete & train at the same show.
- Trainees will not be able to be judged by their Mentor in the current year.
- Trainees will be subject to the Rules & Regulations for TSR including confidentiality and social media.
