TSR SCOTTISH REGIONAL FINALS

*Finals are open to qualified handlers/riders who hold a TSR or Equifest qualification card.
Cards **MUST** be shown to the steward on entering the ring.*

RIDERS MUST NOT HAVE QUALIFIED FOR HOYS IN 2016/2017 TO BE ELIGIBLE

Riders/Handlers DO NOT have to be a TSR Member to compete.

All TSR Members in each FINAL will receive a TSR Members Sash

Who Can Enter?

The finals are open to riders/ handlers who have qualified and hold a TSR card or a signed 2016 Equifest Card and not have qualified for HOYS in 2015/2016. You need to show the card to the steward when you enter the ring so make sure you take a COPY of your Equifest Card before you send in your entries for these shows.

What Classes can I enter?

The **RIDER/HANDLER has qualified** and can enter **ANY of the TSR HORSEZONE.CO.UK Finals on any horse/pony** (it does not have to be the pony/horse they qualified on).

Do I need to be a TSR Member?

You **DO NOT** have to be a TSR to enter.

How do I Enter?

Entries go to the show hosting the final not to TSR. Either enter before the show by online or post OR enter on the day, **DO NOT** send the card in when entering, carry the card in your pocket during the class and show to the steward at the ring.

How are the FINALS judged?

The TSR Finals will be judged using the following Mark System. The Performance Judge will award up to 30 Marks for Performance & up to 30 marks for the Riders/Handlers Skill. The conformation judge will award up to 30 marks for Conformation & 10 for Turnout.

TSR last chance qualifiers throughout the show.

Horse & Country Racehorse Championships 2017 sponsored by Puffin Pellets

The Horse & Country Racehorse (HCR) series is open to Thoroughbreds who have raced, trained or been bred to race. The classes will be judged on conformation, manners, turnout, way of going and the ride/individual show performance; racing injuries will be ignored providing the horse is sound.

The age of your horse, number of times it has raced (if any) and the period of time it has been off the track will also be taken into account.

The Judge will not ride and you will not be asked to gallop as a ride but maybe asked to gallop in your individual show. Evening performance or normal show turnout is permitted (as per the HCR rulebook).

To qualify for these championships the handler/rider and horse must be registered with HCR, you must of qualified and returned your signed qualification card or non-members cards to HCR in advance of the Grand slam.

The combination of horse and handler/rider that qualified must be the same combination that comes forward to this championship show (special circumstances will be considered), all entered horses eligibility will be checked by HCR.

Veteran Horse Society

Scottish Veteran Horse of the Year Grand Final 2017

Qualifications must have been gained at any of the 2017 Scottish Qualifying shows; you must be a Veteran Horse Society Member. All qualified entrants must enter directly through the Veteran Horse Society.

Champion and reserve from each class forward to the Overall Championship to find the *Scottish Veteran Horse of the year* Marking System Paces maximum 50 marks. Confirmation maximum 20 marks Turnout maximum 10 marks Manners and Way of Going maximum 20 marks - Bad manners are NOT considered the same as the enjoyment and zest for life. Any marks noted incorrectly/inadvertently by the steward may be adjusted and must be signed/initialled by the judge. No half marks will be allowed. Galloping is not allowed in any Veteran Horse Showing classes. Kindly Sponsored by Allan & Page Quality Feeds. VHS Rules apply at all times and Exhibitors may be disqualified from the Grand Final if they contravened the rules. Within VHS classes, the age of the horse/pony must be clearly displayed on the offside of the bridle. Any intentional galloping will lead to immediate disqualification. The same veteran and handler/rider combination must carry qualification. No exchange of horse or rider is accepted.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Please ensure you have read these conditions carefully in advance of the competition.

Conditions of entry

- The Judges' decision is final.
- The Centre reserves the right to change any published judges, but will endeavour to inform all pre-entered exhibitors prior to show day.
- Exhibitors are requested to note the timetable. Where an animal is entered in more than one class, the Centre can take no responsibility if a clash in time occurs.
- Where sufficient entries are forward, classes will be split by breed, age or height as appropriate.
- The Centre reserves the right to cancel or amalgamate classes in the event of insufficient entries.
- Unaffiliated classes will be judged guided by the rules for that section's appropriate affiliated Society (i.e. The Veteran Horse Society, British Show Horse Association, Equifest, Sporthorse GB etc). Copies of rule books will be available at the Secretary's desk for competitors to avail themselves of if required
- An exhibitor may not knowingly exhibit a pony bred, sold, leased, produced, broken or trained by the judge.
- A rider/handler may not compete in a class judged by someone for whom he/she has exhibited for payment in the show ring within the previous 12 months.
- An exhibitor may not show under a judge for whom she or he has produced a pony for payment within the previous 12 months (an exhibitor is the owner, the lessee or the person who produces and/or shows the pony).
- The Centre reserves the right to refuse any entry. Entries must include the correct fees. No substitution or nomination entries will be accepted.
- Entries will only be refunded when accompanied by a valid signed veterinary report.
- **Objections shall be made in writing within 30 minutes of the event concerned and lodged with the Secretary together with the sum of £50, which shall be refunded if the objection is upheld.**

Health and Safety

- The Centre has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all the Officials and Stewards.
- Dogs must be kept on a lead AT ALL TIMES. Please clean up after your dog. No dogs permitted within the centre buildings
- In the interest of safety, adults must give due consideration to children while riding in collecting rings and warm up areas.
- The number of horses working in the collecting ring may be limited by number and/or to entrants in the next class only.

- Beaglers, top hats and bowlers may only be worn if a signed disclaimer has been returned to the Secretary.
- Competitors under 16 years of age MUST wear an appropriate strapped hat when handling or riding an animal in the warm-up area or ring.
- Stallions and colts must be sufficiently restrained at all times and handled by a competent person over 14 years.
- Competitors may be asked to leave the showground if the Organisers consider a stallion or colt to be insufficiently controlled.
- All animals must be sound. If, in the opinion of the judge, an animal is considered to be unsound, the exhibitor may be asked to withdraw from the class. The judge's decision is final.
- Any animal found to be suffering from a contagious or infectious disease will be asked to leave the showground immediately.
- Any competitor, rider, groom or handler who acts in an abusive or aggressive manner towards any animal, spectator, official, volunteer or member of Ingliston staff will forfeit all entries and/or prize money and will be asked to leave the showground.
