Competitor Information

This information should be read in conjunction with The Showing Register Premier Amateur Show 2024 Schedule.

The TSR Premier Amateur Show is for Amateur and Home Produced competitors only. All exhibitors, horses and ponies must meet the TSR Amateur definition listed in the TSR Handbook 2024. Please make sure you have read and fully understand the eligibility to take part in classes being held at the Show. Details can be found at www.theshowingregister.co.uk under the TSR Handbook 2024 TSR Handbook

The Showing Register TSR takes very seriously the spirit of these amateur/home-produced conditions any member or participant found to be contravening them may be subject to exclusion from the society and the Show with immediate effect. If you are in any doubt about your status please ask the office for guidance, the decision of The Showing Register on eligibility will be final.

KEY INFORMATION

Entries & Stabling

- Entries will be accepted on the day. Card or Cash payment only.
- Only competitors who have pre-booked stabling will be allowed to access the stable area. You will not be able to book any stabling on the day.
- If you have booked hook up please ensure you display the relevant pass on arrival and the stable team will park you accordingly.

Equestrian Office/Admin

- The office will be located in the Foreman of the Horse building.
- Please note that competitors with horses and/or ponies arriving at NAEC, Stoneleigh Park will ONLY be admitted during the following times:

- No competitor horseboxes or trailers will be allowed entry via the main gate. Please ensure you follow the relevant Road signs for Gate 3 and the postcode CV8 2LA. What Three Words code - medium.actors.bunk.
- Visitors travelling by car **must** arrive through the main entrance, please follow postcode CV8 2LH.

SHOWING COMPETITORS

Competitor back numbers are included in this pack and must be worn in the ring. For competitors who have multiple entries, please ensure you are wearing the correct number in each class.

VACCINATIONS

It is the owner's responsibility to ensure that the horse's vaccinations are up to date and correctly recorded. Spot checks will be regularly carried out at shows.

Please ensure your horse/pony is in compliance with the vaccinations requirements as below:

Equine Influenza Vaccination Requirements

Primary Course	V1 (initial vaccination): Day 0 V2 (second vaccination): Day 21-92	V1 (initial vaccination): Day 0 V2 (second vaccination): Day 21-60
First Booster	V3 (first booster): Day 150 - 215	V3 (first booster): Within 6 months and 21 days of V2
Subsequent Boosters	Within 12 months of previous booster vaccination.	Within 12 months of previous booster vaccination.

None of these injections must have been given within the preceding 7 (seven) days including the day of the competition or of entry into the competition stables. For full vaccination policy please see the HOYS website.

STABLING

Stables are booked from 17:00 on the day of arrival until 16:00 on the day of departure from Friday to Sunday. Please note: all stables must be vacated by 08:00 on Monday 27th May, unless staying on for the SEIB Search for a Star Show. Vacated stables must be left mucked out and banked up.

A deposit of £20 per stable is required, payable by card or cash to the Stable Managers on arrival. This will be refunded on departure following inspection by the Stable Managers to ensure the stable has been left mucked out, clean, tidy and in good repair. Failure to vacate stables by the allocated times (4pm Saturday, 4pm Sunday and 8am Monday) may result in the loss of the £20 stable deposit. Stable deposits not collected at the show will be forfeited.

On arrival, please report to the Stable Manager's Office where you will be given all relevant information and can arrange collection of any pre-ordered bedding. Straw bedding is not permitted on site. **Please note that no bedding will be provided free of charge.**

EXERCISE ARENAS

The external Exercise Areas will only be open during the following times:

Friday 24 th May 2024	17:00 – 20:00
Saturday 25 th May 2024	06:30 – 20:00
Sunday 26 th May 2024	06:30 – 18:00

No horse or pony will be allowed into the Competition Arenas for exercise at any time, any horse or pony found exercising in the competition arenas may be unable to compete. No horse or pony will be allowed into the external Exercise Areas except at such times as are announced or posted, or as stated in the timetable. If the outside exercise arena is closed, under no circumstances is anyone on the showground permitted to use any arena or other areas on the showground for exercise. Please note that you will only be able to enter the designated warm up area 30 minutes before the start of your class. No access to the warm up area will allowed before this time.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURE

Emergency services must always have access to the entire show site and attendees must not park vehicles to obstruct access. Should you require urgent medical attention please contact your nearest steward or member of the Show Team.

Veterinary cover will be available throughout the show on an on-call basis. Please contact Towcester Vets on 01788 523000.
