Class 3	<b>In Hand Youngstock</b> yearling, 2 and 3 year olds Any type
Class 4	<b>In Hand Coloured</b> all types including Traditional Gypsy Cobs 4 years and over
Class 5	<b>In Hand Coloured</b> all types youngstock including Gypsy Cobs yearling 2 and 3 year olds
Class 6	<b>In Hand veteran</b> 15 years and over

**Ring 2 (Indoors) 0930**

**Judge: Zoe Moore-Williams**

Class 13      **Novice Lead Rein** 4 years old and over not exc 128cms– any type

Class 14      **Novice First ridden** 4 years old and over not exc 128cms – any type

Class 15      **TSR Amateur of the Year Plaited Lead Rein** Pony mare or gelding 4 years old and over not exceeding 128cms. Riders to have attained their 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday but not their 9<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

Class 16      **TSR Amateur of the Year Plaited First Ridden Pony**, mare or gelding 4 years old and over not exceeding 128cms. Riders to have attained their 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday but not their 10<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle.

Class 17      **TSR Amateur of Year M & M Lead Rein** Open to Mountain and Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A and Welsh B. Stallion, mare or gelding 4 years and over. Riders any age except for those on stallions who must have attained their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday by 1<sup>st</sup> January of the current year and suitably mounted. Spurs must not be worn.

Class 18      **TSR Amateur of the Year M & M** First Ridden Open to Mountain and Moorland ponies registered with their Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A or B. Mares or geldings 4 years old and over not exceeding 128cms. Riders must have attained their 3<sup>rd</sup> birthdays but not attained their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle.

Class 19      **Novice Ridden Pony** Not exc14.2 – will not canter as a group, snaffle bits only

**Morning Ridden Championship   Classes 13-19**

**Not Before 12.30 – Whole of Indoor**

Class 20      **Novice Ridden Horse** 14.2 and over 4 years old and over. Will not canter as a group – Any type -**Judge: Mrs Zoe Moore-Williams**

Class 21      **TSR Amateur of the Year Open plaited pony**, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms. Any suitably mounted rider. Spurs must not be worn. **Judge: Mrs Zoe Moore Williams**

Class 22      **TSR Amateur of the Year Small Breeds** Open to Mountain and Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A and Welsh B. Stallion, mare or gelding 4 years and over. Riders any age except for those on stallions who must have attained their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday by 1<sup>st</sup> January of the current year and suitably mounted. Spurs must not be worn. **Judge: Mrs Tracy Hook**

Class 23      **TSR Amateur of the Year Large Breeds** Open to Mountain and Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Fells, Dales, Highlands, New Forests, Connemara, Welsh C and Welsh D. Stallion, mare or gelding 4 years and over. Riders any age except for those on stallions who must have attained their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday by 1<sup>st</sup> January of the current year. Spurs must not be worn. **Judge: Tracy Hook**

Class 24      **TSR Amateur of the Year Ridden Veteran** Open to horses and ponies of any breed, type and height, 15 years and over. Riders of any age, suitably mounted – animals will not be galloped. Spurs not to be worn. Blemishes are not taken into consideration. **Judge: Zoe Moore Williams**

Class 25

**TSR Amateur of the Year Ridden Coloured Horse/Pony**

*Ponies:* Open Ridden Piebald/Skewbald, stallion, mare or gelding 4 years and over. Riders any age except for those on stallions who must have attained their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday by 1<sup>st</sup> January of the current year. Spurs must not be worn. Ponies under 153 cms.

*Horses:* Open Ridden Piebald/Skewbald, stallion, mare or gelding 4 years and over. Riders any age except for those on stallions who must have attained their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday by 1<sup>st</sup> January of the current year Spurs may be worn by adult riders. Animals 153cms and over. **Judge Tracy Hook**

***Class 26 will if entries warrant be split. Two Highest placed in each classification will qualify***

Class 26

**TSR Amateur of the Year Hack/Riding Horse Cob or Hunter**

Open Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Exceeding 148cms. To be shown hogged and trimmed. . Riders must have attained their 15<sup>th</sup> birthday by the day of the Show Spurs may be worn by adult riders

Open Ridden Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Exceeding 148cms. . Riders must have attained their 15<sup>th</sup> birthday by the day of the Show. Spurs may be worn by adult riders

Open to Hacks and Riding Horses. mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Exceeding 148cms but Hacks not exceeding 160cms. Riders must have attained their 15<sup>th</sup> birthday by the day of the Show Spurs may be worn by adult riders **Judge: Russell Marks**

**Afternoon Ridden Championship - Classes 20-26**

**Rules:**

Strictly no Lunging in any of the Arenas

Horses must not be left unattended tied to a horse box on the Car Park

Only Horses competing are allowed to use the Warm up Arena

Please do not skip out lorries on to the car park, put any droppings in trailer provided.

All dogs must be kept on leads

Correct British Standard Headgear conforming to BS4472, BS6473 or current standards to be worn at all times when mounted. – Strapped hats must be worn whilst mounted

All riders with long hair are recommended to keep their hair above shoulder length for their own safety.
